

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 2406, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. BEATTY OF OHIO**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1       **TITLE XVII—JOHN P. PARKER**  
2                                   **HOUSE STUDY**

3       **SEC. 1701. SHORT TITLE.**

4           This title may be cited as the “John P. Parker House  
5 Study Act”.

6       **SEC. 1702. DEFINITIONS.**

7           In this title:

8                   (1) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means  
9 the Secretary of the Interior.

10                   (2) **STUDY AREA.**—The term “study area”  
11 means the John P. Parker House in Ripley, Ohio,  
12 which was recognized as a National Historic Land-  
13 mark in 1997.

14       **SEC. 1703. SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY OF JOHN P. PARKER**  
15                                   **HOUSE.**

16           (a) **STUDY.**—The Secretary shall conduct a special  
17 resource study of the study area to determine the suit-  
18 ability and feasibility of establishing the John P. Parker  
19 House in Ripley, Ohio, as a unit of the National Park Sys-  
20 tem.

1           (b) STUDY REQUIREMENTS.—The Secretary shall  
2 conduct the study in accordance with section 100507 of  
3 title 54, United States Code.

4           (c) REPORT.—Not later than 3 years after the date  
5 on which funds are made available to carry out this title,  
6 the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on Natural  
7 Resources of the House of Representatives and the Com-  
8 mittee on Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate  
9 a report that describes—

10                   (1) the results of the study; and

11                   (2) any recommendations of the Secretary.
