"(m) EFFECT ON VULNERABLE POPULATIONS.—If
the Administrator determines that implementation of this
section would diminish protections for vulnerable popu lations, the requirements of this section shall have no force
or effect.

Page 47, line 6, redesignate subsection (m) as subsection (n).

Page 50, line 17, strike the closed quotation mark and the final period.

Page 50, after line 17, insert the following:

6	"(9) VULNERABLE POPULATION.—The term
7	'vulnerable population' means a population that is
8	subject to a disproportionate exposure to, or poten-
9	tial for a disproportionate adverse effect from expo-
10	sure to, coal combustion residuals, including—
11	"(A) infants, children, and adolescents;
