

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1459, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. CONNOLLY OF VIRGINIA**

Page 4, strike lines 14 through 23, and insert the following:

1 “(4) be followed by a feasibility study that in-
2 cludes an estimate of regional economic benefits and
3 the costs associated with managing the monument in
4 perpetuity, including the effects on Federal and
5 State revenue, which shall be submitted to the Com-
6 mittee on Natural Resources of the House of Rep-
7 resentatives and the Committee on Energy and Nat-
8 ural Resources of the Senate and made available on
9 the website of the Department of Interior not later
10 than one year after the date of declaration.”.
