

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1735
OFFERED BY MR. FRANKS OF ARIZONA

At the appropriate place in title XII of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 12xx. SUPPORT FOR UNITED STATES DIPLOMATIC EF-**
2 **FORTS WITH RESPECT TO IRAN.**

3 (a) STATEMENT OF POLICY.—It is the policy of the
4 United States that it is in the national security interest
5 of the United States and its allies and partners to ensure
6 the following objectives with respect to Iran are achieved:

7 (1) Iran permanently halts all uranium enrich-
8 ment and identifies all sites where such enrichment
9 is occurring.

10 (2) Iran removes, and transfers to a third party
11 under the auspices of the International Atomic En-
12 ergy Agency (IAEA), all uranium enriched to a 20
13 percent and higher threshold.

14 (3) Iran closes the uranium enrichment facility
15 at Fordow, near Qom, Iran.

16 (4) Iran ceases developing reactors capable of
17 producing plutonium and ceases the importation and
18 domestic manufacturing of all centrifuges for enrich-
19 ing uranium.

1 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—It is the sense of Congress
3 that, if the objectives described in paragraphs (1)
4 through (4) of subsection (a) are met, it should be
5 the policy of the United States to enter into a nego-
6 tiated settlement regarding nuclear activities in Iran
7 that includes the terms described in paragraph (2)
8 of this subsection.

9 (2) TERMS DESCRIBED.—The terms referred to
10 in paragraph (1) are the following:

11 (A) The Government of Iran reaffirms its
12 commitment to the Treaty on the Non-Pro-
13 liferation of Nuclear Weapons and ratifies and
14 implements all provisions of the Additional Pro-
15 tocol.

16 (B) Iran ceases the development and test-
17 ing of long-range ballistic weapons.

18 (C) Iran permits unfettered access by
19 IAEA officials to inspect and verify its compli-
20 ance to IAEA safeguards and the IAEA Board
21 of Governors' obligations.

22 (D) Iran ceases to provide weapons, train-
23 ing, funding, and direction to terrorist groups,
24 including Hamas, Hezbollah, Shiite militias in

1 Iraq, and the regime of Bashar al Assad in
2 Syria.

3 (E) Iran demonstrates peaceful foreign
4 policy conduct and actions and issues full rec-
5 ognition of its neighbors' sovereignty, including
6 Israel.

7 (F) Iran ceases all threats against the
8 United States and Israel.
