Page 671, strike line 7 and all that follows through line 19.

Page 842, line 14, strike “**DEFINITIONS**” and insert “**DEFINITION**”.

Page 842, strike lines 15 and 16.

Page 842, line 17, strike “(b) TRANSPORTS.—”.

Page 850, strike line 20 and all that follows through line 3 on page 851 and insert the following:

1 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5107(g)(2) is amended—

2 (1) by striking “An action” and inserting “(A)

3 An action”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(B) Within 180 days of the date of enactment

6 of the American Energy and Infrastructure Jobs Act

7 of 2012, the Secretary ^{shall seek a} ~~and the Secretary of Labor~~

8 ~~shall enter into a~~ Memorandum of Agreement ^{with the Secretary of Labor} to co-

9 ordinate the application of regulations issued by the

1 Department of Transportation and the Department
2 of Labor with regards to protecting the safety and
3 health of hazmat employees, including standards for
4 loading, unloading, and handling hazardous material
5 and training hazmat employees. In developing such
6 Memorandum of Agreement, the ~~Secretaries~~^{Secretary,} of
7 ~~Transportation and Labor~~^{in coordination with the Secretary of Labor,} shall address the poten-
8 tial for duplicative requirements or gaps in cov-
9 erage.”.

10 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 5107(e)(1)
11 is amended by striking “5128(c)” and inserting “5128”.

Page 855, after line 6, insert the following (and re-
designate subsequent subsections accordingly):

12 (a) TRAINING FOR EMERGENCY RESPONDERS.—Sec-
13 tion 5116(b)(1) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
14 lowing: “To the extent that a grant is used to train emer-
15 gency responders, the State or Indian tribe shall certify,
16 in writing, to the Secretary that the emergency responders
17 who receive training under the grant, at a minimum, will
18 have the ability to protect nearby persons, property, and
19 the environment from the effects of accidents or incidents
20 involving the transportation of hazardous material in ac-
21 cordance with existing regulations or national fire protec-
22 tion standards.”.

Page 856, line 12, strike “and”.

Page 856, line 19, strike the period and insert a semicolon.

Page 856, after line 19, insert the following:

1 (4) by redesignating paragraph (5) as para-
2 graph (6); and

3 (5) by inserting after paragraph (4) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(5) The Secretary may make a grant to an or-
6 ganization under this subsection only if the organi-
7 zation ensures that emergency responders who re-
8 ceive training under the grant, at a minimum, will
9 have the ability to protect nearby persons, property,
10 and the environment from the effects of accidents or
11 incidents involving the transportation of hazardous
12 material in accordance with existing regulations or
13 national fire protection standards.”.
