## Amendment to Rules Comm. Print 115–23 Offered by M\_.

At the end of subtitle F of title X, add the following new section:

## 1 SEC. 10\_\_\_\_. PROHIBITION ON USING FUNDS TO CONDUCT 2 WARRANTLESS SEARCHES FOR THE COMMU 3 NICATIONS OF UNITED STATES PERSONS.

4 (a) PROHIBITION ON USING FUNDS FOR THE 5 SEARCHING OF COLLECTIONS OF COMMUNICATIONS OF 6 UNITED STATES PERSONS.—Except as provided in subsection (b), no amounts authorized to be appropriated or 7 otherwise made available to the Department of Defense 8 9 shall be used by an officer or employee of the United 10 States to conduct a search of a collection of communications acquired under section 702 of the Foreign Intel-11 12 ligence Surveillance Act (50 U.S.C. 1881a) in an effort to find communications of a particular United States per-13 14 son (other than a corporation).

(b) CONCURRENT AUTHORIZATION AND EXCEPTION
FOR EMERGENCY SITUATIONS.—Subsection (a) shall not
apply to a search for communications related to a particular United States person if—

(1) such United States person is the subject of
 an order or emergency authorization authorizing
 electronic surveillance or physical search under sec tion 105, 304, 703, 704, or 705 of the Foreign In telligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1801
 et seq.), or title 18, United States Code, for the ef fective period of that order;

8 (2) the entity carrying out the search has a rea-9 sonable belief that the life or safety of such United 10 States person is threatened and the information is 11 sought for the purpose of assisting that person; or 12 (3) such United States person has consented to 13 the search.
