

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5743, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. HOLT OF NEW JERSEY**

After section 501, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 502. DISCLOSURE OF THE NUMBER OF UNITED**
2 **STATES PERSONS WHOSE INFORMATION HAS**
3 **BEEEN ACQUIRED UNDER THE FOREIGN IN-**
4 **TELLIGENCE SURVEILLANCE ACT OF 1978.**

5 (a) **DISCLOSURE REQUIRED.**—Not later than 60 days
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Attorney
7 General, in consultation with the Director of National In-
8 telligence, shall submit to the congressional intelligence
9 committees a report on the number of United States per-
10 sons whose information has been acquired through elec-
11 tronic surveillance authorized in accordance with title I of
12 the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50
13 U.S.C. 1801 et seq.) from the date of the enactment of
14 the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 (Public Law 110-261;
15 50 U.S.C. 1801 note) through the date of the enactment
16 of this Act.

17 (b) **WEBSITE PUBLICATION REQUIRED.**—Not later
18 than 60 days after the date of the enactment of this Act,
19 the Attorney General and the Director of National Intel-
20 ligence shall publish the information described in sub-

1 section (a) on the website of the Department of Justice
2 and the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, re-
3 spectively.

4 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms “United
5 States person” and “electronic surveillance” have the
6 meaning given such terms in section 101 of the Foreign
7 Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1801).
