

**AMENDMENT TO THE SENATE AMENDMENTS
TO H.R. 22
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 114-32
OFFERED BY MR. HUELSKAMP OF KANSAS**

At the end of the bill, add the following new division:

1 DIVISION J—OTHER MATTERS

2 SEC. 99001. REPEAL OF THE PATIENT PROTECTION AND AF-
3 FORDABLE CARE ACT AND THE HEALTH
4 CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILIATION ACT
5 OF 2010.

6 (a) PATIENT PROTECTION AND AFFORDABLE CARE
7 ACT.—Effective on the date that is 180 days after the
8 date of enactment of this Act, the Patient Protection and
9 Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148) is repealed
10 and the provisions of law amended or repealed by such
11 Act are restored or revived as if such Act had not been
12 enacted.

13 (b) HEALTH CARE AND EDUCATION RECONCILI-
14 ATION ACT OF 2010.—Effective on the date that is 180
15 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Health
16 Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010 (Public
17 Law 111-152) is repealed and the provisions of law

1 amended or repealed by such Act are restored or revived
2 as if such Act had not been enacted.

3 (c) BUDGETARY EFFECTS.—The budgetary effects of
4 this section, for the purpose of complying with the Statu-
5 tory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, shall be determined by
6 reference to the latest statement titled “Budgetary Effects
7 of PAYGO Legislation” for this section, submitted for
8 printing in the Congressional Record by the Chairman of
9 the Committee on the Budget of the House of Representa-
10 tives, as long as such statement has been submitted prior
11 to the vote on passage of this Act.
