Page 462, after line 13, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . LIMITATION ON AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS FOR**
2 **DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN LANDMINES AND**
3 **REPORT ON DEVELOPMENT OF REPLACE-**
4 **MENT ANTI-PERSONNEL LANDMINE MUNI-**
5 **TIONS.**

6 (a) **LIMITATION.**—Except as provided in subsection
7 (b), none of the funds authorized to be appropriated by
8 this Act or otherwise made available for fiscal year 2017
9 for the Department of Defense may be obligated or ex-
10 pended for the destruction of anti-personnel landmine mu-
11 nitions before the date on which the Secretary of Defense
12 submits the report required by subsection (c).

13 (b) **EXCEPTION FOR SAFETY.**—Subsection (a) shall
14 not apply to any anti-personnel landmine munitions that
15 the Secretary determines are unsafe or could pose a safety
16 risk if not demilitarized or destroyed.

17 (c) **REPORT REQUIRED.**—

18 (1) **IN GENERAL.**—Not later than 180 days
19 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-

1 retary of Defense shall submit to the Congress a re-
2 port that includes the following:

3 (A) An assessment of the current state of
4 research into operational alternatives to anti-
5 personnel landmines.

6 (B) Any other matter that the Secretary
7 determines should be included in the report.

8 (2) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by
9 paragraph (1) shall be submitted in unclassified
10 form, but may include a classified annex.

11 (d) ANTI-PERSONNEL LANDMINE MUNITIONS DE-
12 FINED.—In this section, the term “anti-personnel land-
13 mine munitions” includes anti-personnel landmines and
14 sub-munitions as defined by the Convention on the Prohi-
15 bition of the Use, Stockpiling, Production and Transfer
16 of Anti-Personnel Mines and on their Destruction, as de-
17 termined by the Secretary.
