Page 818, insert before line 11 the following new section:

1 **SEC. 2854. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING RECOGNITION**
2 **OF NATIONAL MUSEUM OF WORLD WAR II**
3 **AVIATION IN COLORADO SPRINGS, COLO-**
4 **RADO, AS AMERICA'S NATIONAL WORLD WAR**
5 **II AVIATION MUSEUM.**

6 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

7 (1) World War II was one of the most impor-
8 tant events in the history of the Nation, a time of
9 moral clarity and common purpose that remains
10 today as an inspiration to all people in the United
11 States.

12 (2) The role of aviation was a critical factor in
13 the success of winning World War II and defeating
14 the enemies worldwide.

15 (3) The bravery, courage, dedication, and her-
16 oism of World War II aviators and support per-
17 sonnel was an important element in the winning of
18 World War II.

1 (4) The National Museum of World War II
2 Aviation in Colorado Springs, Colorado, is the only
3 museum in the United States that exists to exclu-
4 sively preserve and promote an understanding of the
5 role of aviation in winning World War II.

6 (5) The National Museum of World War II
7 Aviation is dedicated to celebrating the spirit of the
8 United States, recognizing the teamwork, collabora-
9 tion, patriotism, and courage of the men and women
10 who fought, as well as those on the homefront who
11 mobilized and supported the national aviation effort.

12 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
13 gress that the National Museum of World War II Aviation
14 in Colorado Springs, Colorado, should be recognized as
15 America’s National World War II Aviation Museum.
