

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3630

OFFERED BY MR. LEWIS OF GEORGIA

Strike subtitle B of title II of the bill and insert the following (and make all necessary technical and conforming amendments):

1 **Subtitle B—Extension of**
2 **Unemployment Programs**

3 **SEC. 2121. TEMPORARY EXTENSION OF UNEMPLOYMENT**
4 **INSURANCE PROVISIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—(1) Section 4007 of the Supple-
6 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252;
7 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended—

8 (A) by striking “January 3, 2012” each place
9 it appears and inserting “January 3, 2013”;

10 (B) in the heading for subsection (b)(2), by
11 striking “JANUARY 3, 2012” and inserting “JANUARY
12 3, 2013”; and

13 (C) in subsection (b)(3), by striking “June 9,
14 2012” and inserting “June 8, 2013”.

15 (2) Section 2005 of the Assistance for Unemployed
16 Workers and Struggling Families Act, as contained in
17 Public Law 111–5 (26 U.S.C. 3304 note; 123 Stat. 444),
18 is amended—

1 (A) by striking “January 4, 2012” each place
2 it appears and inserting “January 4, 2013”; and

3 (B) in subsection (c), by striking “June 11,
4 2012” and inserting “June 11, 2013”.

5 (3) Section 5 of the Unemployment Compensation
6 Extension Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–449; 26 U.S.C.
7 3304 note) is amended by striking “June 10, 2012” and
8 inserting “June 10, 2013”.

9 (b) FUNDING.—Section 4004(e)(1) of the Supple-
10 mental Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–252;
11 26 U.S.C. 3304 note) is amended—

12 (1) in subparagraph (F), by striking “and” at
13 the end; and

14 (2) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-
15 lowing:

16 “(H) the amendments made by section
17 2121(a)(1) of the Middle Class Tax Relief and
18 Job Creation Act of 2011; and”.

19 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
20 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
21 ment of the Tax Relief, Unemployment Insurance Reau-
22 thorization, and Job Creation Act of 2010 (Public Law
23 111–312).

1 **SEC. 2122. ADDITIONAL EXTENDED UNEMPLOYMENT BENE-**
2 **FITS UNDER THE RAILROAD UNEMPLOY-**
3 **MENT INSURANCE ACT.**

4 (a) EXTENSION.—Section 2(c)(2)(D)(iii) of the Rail-
5 road Unemployment Insurance Act, as added by section
6 2006 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of
7 2009 (Public Law 96 111–5) and as amended by section
8 9 of the Worker, Homeownership, and Business Assist-
9 ance Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–92) and section 505
10 of the Tax Relief, Unemployment Insurance Reauthoriza-
11 tion, and Job Creation Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–
12 312), is amended—

13 (1) by striking “June 30, 2011” and inserting
14 “June 30, 2012”; and

15 (2) by striking “December 31, 2011” and in-
16 serting “January 31, 2012”.

17 (b) CLARIFICATION ON AUTHORITY TO USE
18 FUNDS.—Funds appropriated under either the first or
19 second sentence of clause (iv) of section 2(c)(2)(D) of the
20 Railroad Unemployment Insurance Act shall be available
21 to cover the cost of additional extended unemployment
22 benefits provided under such section 2(c)(2)(D) by reason
23 of the amendments made by subsection (a) as well as to
24 cover the cost of such benefits provided under such section
25 2(c)(2)(D), as in effect on the day before the date of en-
26 actment of this Act.

1 **SEC. 2123. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

2 It is the sense of Congress that the extensions under
3 this subtitle are fully funded by responsibly ending the
4 wars in Afghanistan and Iraq and reducing overseas con-
5 tingency operations funding after 2012.
