

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
FOR H.R. 4909
OFFERED BY MR. SEAN PATRICK MALONEY OF
NEW YORK**

At the end of title X, add the following:

1 SEC. 1098. JCPOA INTELLIGENCE ENFORCEMENT.

2 (a) JCPOA MONITORING.—

3 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director
5 of National Intelligence shall establish an integration
6 cell among relevant elements of the United States
7 intelligence community to integrate intelligence re-
8 lated to monitoring and enforcement of the Joint
9 Comprehensive Plan of Action (hereinafter referred
10 to as the “JCPOA”). The integration cell estab-
11 lished under this subsection shall be known as the
12 “IC Iran Integration Cell” (hereinafter referred to
13 as “the Integration Cell”).

14 (2) PRIMARY FUNCTIONS.—The primary func-
15 tions of the Integration Cell are—

16 (A) to coordinate and synchronize all col-
17 lection related to implementation of the
18 JCPOA;

1 (B) to integrate the early warning systems
2 of intelligence agencies with respect to potential
3 violations of the JCPOA; and

4 (C) to identify intelligence gaps related to
5 monitoring of the JCPOA.

6 (3) LEADERSHIP.—

7 (A) IN GENERAL.—The Integration Cell
8 shall be headed by a member of the Senior In-
9 telligence Service, who shall report to the Direc-
10 tor of National Intelligence.

11 (B) STAFFING.— The cell may be staffed
12 through detailees, assignees, or core contractor
13 personnel who would otherwise conduct such
14 work as part of their normal responsibilities.

15 (4) REPORTS.—Not later than six months after
16 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually
17 thereafter, the Director of National Intelligence shall
18 submit to Congress a report on the Integration Cell
19 that includes each of the following:

20 (A) A detailed description of the activities
21 of the Integration Cell.

22 (B) An assessment of the awareness of the
23 Integration Cell of Iran's compliance with the
24 JCPOA.

1 (C) Recommendations for better collection
2 regarding Iran's compliance.

3 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING ESTABLISH-
4 MENT OF JOINT INTELLIGENCE FUSION CELL.—It is the
5 sense of Congress that the intelligence community should
6 establish a joint fusion cell with members of the Gulf Co-
7 operation Council to—

8 (1) combat Iran's malevolent regional activities,
9 including Iran's support for terrorist proxy entities,
10 such as Hezbollah;

11 (2) find and disrupt illicit transfers of weapons
12 and material, in violation of United Nations Security
13 Council Resolution 2231; and

14 (3) protect the territorial integrity of key part-
15 ner nations.

16 (c) SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING JOINT UNITED
17 STATES-ISRAEL INTELLIGENCE COOPERATION.—It is the
18 sense of Congress that—

19 (1) the Director of National Intelligence should
20 establish a United States-Israel intelligence working
21 group focused specifically on the Iranian threat; and

22 (2) such working group should meet on a reg-
23 ular basis to enhance intelligence sharing on threats,
24 including—

1 (A) Iranian support for Hezbollah and
2 other terrorist actors;

3 (B) Iranian illicit smuggling of conven-
4 tional weapons;

5 (C) monitoring and collection of intel-
6 ligence on Iran's ballistic missile and space pro-
7 grams, including its pursuit of satellite pro-
8 grams; and

9 (D) monitoring and collection of intel-
10 ligence on Iran's nuclear activities.
