

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3080, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY Ms. McCOLLUM OF MINNESOTA AND
MR. KELLY OF PENNSYLVANIA

At the end of title I of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 139. MULTIAGENCY EFFORT TO SLOW THE SPREAD OF**
2 **ASIAN CARP IN THE UPPER MISSISSIPPI**
3 **RIVER AND OHIO RIVER BASINS AND TRIBU-**
4 **TARIES.**

5 (a) MULTIAGENCY EFFORT TO SLOW THE SPREAD
6 OF ASIAN CARP IN THE UPPER MISSISSIPPI AND OHIO
7 RIVER BASINS AND TRIBUTARIES.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Director of the United
9 States Fish and Wildlife Service, in coordination
10 with the Chief of Engineers, the Director of the Na-
11 tional Park Service, and the Director of the United
12 States Geological Survey, shall lead a multiagency
13 effort to slow the spread of Asian carp in the Upper
14 Mississippi and Ohio River basins and tributaries by
15 providing high-level technical assistance, coordina-
16 tion, best practices, and support to State and local
17 governments in carrying out activities designed to
18 slow, and eventually eliminate, the threat posed by
19 Asian carp.

1 (2) BEST PRACTICES.—To the maximum extent
2 practicable, the multiagency effort shall apply les-
3 sons learned and best practices such as those de-
4 scribed in the document prepared by the Asian Carp
5 Working Group entitled “Management and Control
6 Plan for Bighead, Black, Grass, and Silver Carps in
7 the United States” and dated November 2007, and
8 the document prepared by the Asian Carp Regional
9 Coordinating Committee entitled “FY 2012 Asian
10 Carp Control Strategy Framework” and dated Feb-
11 ruary 2012.

12 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—

13 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than December 31
14 of each year, the Director of the United States Fish
15 and Wildlife Service, in coordination with the Chief
16 of Engineers, shall submit to the Committee on Ap-
17 propriations and the Committee on Natural Re-
18 sources of the House of Representatives and the
19 Committee on Appropriations and the Committee on
20 Environment and Public Works of the Senate a re-
21 port describing the coordinated strategies established
22 and progress made toward the goals of controlling
23 and eliminating Asian carp in the Upper Mississippi
24 and Ohio River basins and tributaries.

1 (2) CONTENTS.—Each report submitted under
2 paragraph (1) shall include—

3 (A) any observed changes in the range of
4 Asian carp in the Upper Mississippi and Ohio
5 River basins and tributaries during the 2-year
6 period preceding submission of the report;

7 (B) a summary of Federal agency efforts,
8 including cooperative efforts with non-Federal
9 partners, to control the spread of Asian carp in
10 the Upper Mississippi and Ohio River basins
11 and tributaries;

12 (C) any research that the Director deter-
13 mines could improve the ability to control the
14 spread of Asian carp;

15 (D) any quantitative measures that the Di-
16 rector intends to use to document progress in
17 controlling the spread of Asian carp; and

18 (E) a cross-cut accounting of Federal and
19 non-Federal expenditures to control the spread
20 of Asian carp.
