1SEC. 1038. PROHIBITION ON ENFORCEMENT OF MILITARY2COMMISSION RULINGS PREVENTING MEM-3BERS OF THE ARMED FORCES FROM CAR-4RYING OUT OTHERWISE LAWFUL DUTIES5BASED ON MEMBER GENDER.

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—No order, ruling, finding, or 7 other determination of a military commission may be con-8 strued or implemented to prohibit or restrict a member 9 of the Armed Forces from carrying out duties otherwise 10 lawfully assigned to such member to the extent that the 11 basis for such prohibition or restriction is the gender of 12 such member.

(b) APPLICABILITY TO PRIOR ORDERS, ETC..—In the
case of an order, ruling, finding, or other determination
described in subsection (a) that was issued before the date
of the enactment of this Act in a military commission and
is still effective as of the date of the enactment of this
Act, such order, ruling, finding, or determination shall be
deemed to be vacated and null and void only to the extent

of any prohibition or restriction on the duties of members
 of the Armed Forces that is based on the gender of mem bers.

4 (c) MILITARY COMMISSION DEFINED.—In this sec5 tion, the term "military commission" means a military
6 commission established under chapter 47A of title 10,
7 United States Code, and any military commission other8 wise established or convened by law.
