

**AMENDMENT OFFERED BY MR. MULVANEY OF  
SOUTH CAROLINA**

**TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUB-  
STITUTE OFFERED BY MR. ROGERS OF KEN-  
TUCKY**

After section 904 (but before the short title), insert  
the following new section:

1       SEC. 905. (a) Subparagraph (B) of section 132(f)(1)  
2 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by in-  
3 serting before the period at the end the following: “, except  
4 a transit pass provided by the Federal Government to an  
5 employee of the Federal Government”. The amendment  
6 made by this subsection shall apply to fringe benefits pro-  
7 vided for months beginning after the date of the enact-  
8 ment of this Act.

9       (b) Sections 1103 and 1303 of the Food, Conserva-  
10 tion, and Energy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 8713, 8753) are  
11 repealed.

12       (c) The Secretary of the Treasury may not obligate  
13 any additional funds under title I of the Emergency Eco-  
14 nomic Stabilization Act (12 U.S.C. 5211 et seq.) after the  
15 date of the enactment of this Act.
