

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
FOR H.R. 5
OFFERED BY MR. DELANEY OF MARYLAND**

Page 235, line 4, strike “and” at the end.

Page 235, line 9, strike the period at the end and insert “; and”.

Page 235, after line 9, insert the following:

1 “(F) Support State or local pay for success
2 initiatives that produce a measurable, clearly
3 defined outcome that results in social benefit
4 and direct cost savings to the local, State, or
5 Federal Government to meet the purposes of
6 this part.”.

Page 241, line 4, strike “or” at the end.

Page 241, line 7, strike the period at the end and insert “; or”.

Page 241, after line 7, insert the following:

7 “(10) carrying out activities related to pay for
8 success initiatives that produce a measurable, clearly
9 defined outcome that results in social benefit and di-

1 rect cost savings to the local, State, or Federal Gov-
2 ernment to meet the purposes of this part.”.

Page 250, after line 20, insert the following:

3 “(ix) Supporting State or local pay for
4 success initiatives that produce a measur-
5 able, clearly defined outcome that results
6 in social benefit and direct cost savings to
7 the local, State, or Federal Government to
8 meet the purposes of this part.”.

Page 257, line 25, strike “and” at the end.

Page 258, line 3, strike the period at the end and
insert “; and”.

Page 258, after line 3, insert the following:

9 “(I) carrying out activities related to pay
10 for success initiatives that produce a measur-
11 able, clearly defined outcome that results in so-
12 cial benefit and direct cost savings to the local,
13 State, or Federal Government to meet the pur-
14 poses of this part.”.

Page 508, after line 17, insert the following (and re-
designate the succeeding provisions accordingly):

1 “(34) PAY FOR SUCCESS INITIATIVES.—The
2 term ‘pay for success initiatives’ means initiatives—

3 “(A) that produce a measurable, clearly
4 defined outcome that results in social benefit
5 and direct cost savings to the local, State, or
6 Federal Government;

7 “(B) except as provided in subparagraph
8 (C)(ii), that make payments only when agreed-
9 upon outcomes are achieved; and

10 “(C) for which—

11 “(i) the state/local educational agency,
12 as part of its plan, submits to the Sec-
13 retary a feasibility study on the initiative
14 describing how the proposed intervention is
15 based on strong or moderate evidence of
16 effectiveness and how the initiative will
17 meet the requirements of subparagraph
18 (A);

19 “(ii) an evaluation, which may be paid
20 for out of funding for the pay for success
21 initiative without respect to a successful
22 outcome, is included that uses experi-
23 mental designs using random assignment
24 or other research methodologies that allow
25 for the strongest possible causal inferences

1 when random assignment is not feasible by
2 an independent evaluator to determine
3 whether the initiative has met the out-
4 comes described in subparagraph (A); and
5 “(iii) the State or local educational
6 agency produces an annual, publicly avail-
7 able report on the progress of the initiative
8 in meeting the requirements of subpara-
9 graph (A), as appropriate.”.

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
