Page 384, after line 15, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 1038. DECLASSIFICATION OF INFORMATION ON PAST**  
2 **TERRORIST ACTIVITIES OF DETAINEES**  
3 **TRANSFERRED FROM UNITED STATES NAVAL**  
4 **STATION, GUANTANAMO BAY, CUBA, AFTER**  
5 **SIGNING OF EXECUTIVE ORDER 13492.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days after the  
7 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National  
8 Intelligence shall—

9 (1) complete a declassification review of intel-  
10 ligence reports prepared by the National  
11 Counterterrorism Center prior to Periodic Review  
12 Board sessions or detainee transfers on the past ter-  
13 rorist activities of individuals detained at United  
14 States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, who  
15 were transferred or released from United States  
16 Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, after the signing  
17 of Executive Order 13492 (relating to the closure of  
18 the detention facility at United States Naval Sta-  
19 tion, Guantanamo Bay); and

1           (2) make available to the public any informa-  
2           tion declassified as a result of the declassification re-  
3           view; and

4           (3) submit to the appropriate congressional  
5           committees, consistent with the protection of sources  
6           and methods, a report setting forth—

7                   (A) the results of the declassification re-  
8                   view; and

9                   (B) if any information covered by the de-  
10                  classification review was not declassified pursu-  
11                  ant to the review, a justification for the deter-  
12                  mination not to declassify such information.

13          (b) PAST TERRORIST ACTIVITIES.—For purposes of  
14          this section, the past terrorist activities of an individual  
15          shall include the terrorist activities conducted by the indi-  
16          vidual before the transfer of the individual to the detention  
17          facility at United States Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay,  
18          including, at a minimum, the following:

19                   (1) The terrorist organization, if any, with  
20                   which affiliated.

21                   (2) The terrorist training, if any, received.

22                   (3) The role in past terrorist attacks against  
23                   the interests or allies of the United States.

1           (4) The direct responsibility, if any, for the  
2 death of citizens of the United States or members of  
3 the Armed Forces.

4           (5) Any admission of any matter specified in  
5 paragraphs (1) through (4).

6           (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-  
7 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
8 sional committees” means—

9           (1) the congressional defense committees;

10           (2) the Committee on Foreign Affairs of the  
11 House of Representatives;

12           (3) the Committee on Foreign Relations of the  
13 Senate;

14           (4) the Permanent Committee on Intelligence of  
15 the House of Representatives; and

16           (5) the Select Committee on Intelligence of the  
17 Senate.
