3 “(b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the
4 Congress that the Secretary should review all regulations
5 addressing issues of student privacy, including those under
6 section 444 of the General Education Provisions Act (20
7 U.S.C. 1232g) (commonly known as the ‘Family Edu-
8 cation Rights and Privacy Act of 1974’), and ensure that
9 students’ personally identifiable information is protected.
