## AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT OF H.R. 1960

## OFFERED BY MR. RADEL OF FLORIDA

At the end of subtitle I of title X, add the following new section:

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. PROHIBITION ON USE OF LETHAL MILITARY 2 FORCE AGAINST CITIZENS OF THE UNITED 3 STATES WITHIN THE UNITED STATES.

4 (a) PROHIBITION.—The President may not use lethal
5 military force against a citizen of the United States who
6 is located in the United States.

7 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition under subsection
8 (a) shall not apply to the President using lethal military
9 force against an individual if the President determines
10 that—

(1) the individual poses an imminent threat of
death or serious bodily injury to another individual;
and

14 (2) using such force will prevent or minimize15 such deaths or serious bodily injuries.

16 (c) CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this section shall be 17 construed to suggest that the Constitution would otherwise allow the killing of a citizen of the United States
 without due process of law.

- 3 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
- 4 (1) The term "lethal military force" means a 5 targeted killing or other lethal action by the Federal 6 Government that is typically used against an enemy 7 of the United States, including through the use of 8 an unmanned aircraft or other aircraft, regardless of 9 the department or agency carrying out the targeted 10 killing or other action.
- (2) The term "serious bodily injury" has the
  meaning given that term in section 1365(h)(3) of
  title 18, United States Code.
- 14 (3) The term "United States", as used in a ter15 ritorial sense, has the meaning given that term in
  16 section 5 of title 18, United States Code.
- 17 (4) The term "unmanned aircraft" has the
  18 meaning given that term in section 331(8) of the
  19 FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012 (49
  20 U.S.C. 40101 note).
