

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE

OFFERED BY MS. SHEA-PORTER OF NEW
HAMPSHIRE

Add at the end of subtitle C of title VII, the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL STUDY ON**
2 **HEALTH IMPLICATIONS OF PER- AND**
3 **POLYFLUOROALKYL SUBSTANCES CONTAMI-**
4 **NATION IN DRINKING WATER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
6 Human Services, acting through the Centers for Disease
7 Control and Prevention and the Agency for Toxic Sub-
8 stances and Disease Registry and in consultation with the
9 Department of Defense, shall—

10 (1) commence a study on the human health im-
11 plications of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances
12 (PFAS) contamination in drinking water, ground
13 water, and any other sources of water and relevant
14 exposure vectors, including the cumulative human
15 health implications of multiple types of PFAS con-
16 tamination at levels above and below health advisory
17 levels;

1 (2) not later than 5 years after the date of en-
2 actment of this Act (or 7 years after such date of
3 enactment after providing notice to the appropriate
4 congressional committees of the need for the
5 delay)—

6 (A) complete such study and make any ap-
7 propriate recommendations; and

8 (B) submit a report to the appropriate
9 congressional committees on the results of such
10 study; and

11 (3) not later than one year after the date of the
12 enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter until
13 submission of the report under paragraph (2)(B),
14 submit to the appropriate congressional committees
15 a report on the progress of the study.

16 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

17 (1) AUTHORIZATION.—There is authorized to
18 be appropriated \$7,000,000 to carry out this section.

19 (2) OFFSET.—The amount authorized to be ap-
20 propriated for fiscal year 2018 for the Department
21 of Defense by section 301 for operation and mainte-
22 nance is hereby reduced by \$7,000,000, with the
23 amount of such decrease to be allocated to operation
24 and maintenance, Navy, SAG OMIT, as specified in
25 the funding tables in section 4301.

1 (c) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES DE-
2 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-
3 sional committees” means—

4 (1) the congressional defense committees;

5 (2) the Committee on Health, Education, Labor,
6 and Pensions and the Committee on Veterans’ Af-
7 fairs of the Senate; and

8 (3) the Committee on Energy and Commerce
9 and the Committee on Veterans’ Affairs of the
10 House of Representatives.
