

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 114-64**  
**OFFERED BY MR. POMPEO OF KANSAS**

Page 11, after line 21, add the following:

1 **SEC. 10. SANCTIONS WITH RESPECT TO IRANIAN PERSONS**  
2 **THAT HOLD OR DETAIN UNITED STATES CITI-**  
3 **ZENS.**

4 (a) IMPOSITION OF SANCTIONS.—Not later than 60  
5 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Presi-  
6 dent shall impose the sanctions described in subsection (b)  
7 with respect to—

8 (1) any Iranian person involved in the kidnap-  
9 ping or unjust detention of a United States citizen  
10 on or after March 9, 2007, including a United  
11 States citizen who is also a citizen of another coun-  
12 try;

13 (2) any Iranian person that engages, or at-  
14 tempts to engage, in an activity or transaction that  
15 materially contributes to, or poses a risk of materi-  
16 ally contributing to, kidnapping or unjust detention  
17 described in paragraph (1); and

18 (3) any Iranian person that—

19 (A) is owned or controlled by a person de-  
20 scribed in paragraph (1) or (2);

1 (B) is acting for or on behalf of such a  
2 person; or

3 (C) provides, or attempts to provide—

4 (i) financial, material, technological,  
5 or other support to a person described in  
6 paragraph (1) or (2); or

7 (ii) goods or services in support of an  
8 activity or transaction described in para-  
9 graph (1) or (2).

10 (b) SANCTIONS DESCRIBED.—The President shall  
11 block, in accordance with the International Emergency  
12 Economic Powers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.), all trans-  
13 actions in all property and interests in property of any  
14 person subject to subsection (a) if such property and inter-  
15 ests in property are in the United States, come within the  
16 United States, or are or come within the possession or  
17 control of a United States person.

18 (c) EXCEPTION; PENALTIES.—

19 (1) INAPPLICABILITY OF NATIONAL EMER-  
20 GENCY REQUIREMENT.—The requirements of section  
21 202 of the International Emergency Economic Pow-  
22 ers Act (50 U.S.C. 1701) shall not apply for pur-  
23 poses of subsection (b).

24 (2) EXCEPTION RELATING TO IMPORTATION OF  
25 GOODS.—The requirement to block and prohibit all

1 transactions in all property and interests in property  
2 under subsection (b) shall not include the authority  
3 to impose sanctions on the importation of goods.

4 (3) PENALTIES.—The penalties provided for in  
5 subsections (b) and (c) of section 206 of the Inter-  
6 national Emergency Economic Powers Act (50  
7 U.S.C. 1705) shall apply to a person that violates,  
8 attempts to violate, conspires to violate, or causes a  
9 violation of regulations prescribed under subsection  
10 (b) to the same extent that such penalties apply to  
11 a person that commits an unlawful act described in  
12 subsection (a) of such section 206.

13 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

14 (1) ENTITY.—The term “entity” means a cor-  
15 poration, business association, partnership, trust, so-  
16 ciety, or any other entity.

17 (2) IRANIAN PERSON.—The term “Iranian per-  
18 son” means—

19 (A) an individual who is a citizen or na-  
20 tional of the Islamic Republic of Iran; or

21 (B) an entity organized under the laws of  
22 the Islamic Republic of Iran or otherwise sub-  
23 ject to the jurisdiction of the Government of the  
24 Islamic Republic of Iran.

1           (3) PERSON.—The term “person” means an in-  
2           dividual or entity.

3           (4) UNITED STATES PERSON.—The term  
4           “United States person” means—

5                   (A) a United States citizen or an alien law-  
6                   fully admitted for permanent residence to the  
7                   United States; or

8                   (B) an entity organized under the laws of  
9                   the United States or of any jurisdiction within  
10                  the United States, including a foreign branch of  
11                  such an entity.
