

**AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT
OF H.R. 4310
OFFERED BY MR. WELCH OF VERMONT**

At the end of subtitle I of title V, add the following
new section:

1 SEC. 596. INCREASED FUNDING FOR STATE-LED PROGRAMS
2 OF OUTREACH UNDER YELLOW RIBBON RE-
3 INTEGRATION PROGRAM.

4 (a) PROGRAMS OF OUTREACH.—Of the amounts au-
5 thORIZED to be appropriated by this Act or otherwise made
6 available for fiscal year 2013 for the Department of De-
7 fense, not less than \$72,400,000 may be used for State-
8 led programs of outreach carried out pursuant to sub-
9 section (j) of section 582 of the National Defense Author-
10 ization Act for Fiscal Year 2008 (10 U.S.C. 10101 note),
11 as added by section 590(c) of the National Defense Au-
12 thorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (Public Law 112–
13 81; 125 Stat. 1438).

14 (b) FUNDING.—

15 (1) INCREASE.—Notwithstanding the amounts
16 set forth in the funding tables in division D, the
17 amounts authorized to be appropriated in section
18 301 and 421 for operation and maintenance and

1 military personnel, as specified in the corresponding
2 funding tables in section 4301 and 4401, respec-
3 tively, are hereby increased by a total of
4 \$72,400,000 (\$35,455,830 for operation and main-
5 tenance and \$36,954,170 for military personnel), to
6 be distributed as follows.

7 (A) The amount authorized to be appro-
8 priated in section 4301 for operation and main-
9 tenance, Army National Guard, is hereby in-
10 creased by \$10,288,821..

11 (B) The amount authorized to be appro-
12 priated in section 4401 for military personnel,
13 Army National Guard, is hereby increased by
14 \$20,743,915.

15 (C) The amount authorized to be appro-
16 priated in section 4301 for operation and main-
17 tenance, Army Reserve, is hereby increased by
18 \$11,120,909.

19 (D) The amount authorized to be appro-
20 priated in section 4401 for military personnel,
21 Army Reserve is hereby increased by
22 \$5,329,195.

23 (E) The amount authorized to be appro-
24 priated in section 4301 for operation and main-

1 tenance, Air National Guard, is hereby in-
2 creased by \$7,917,780.

3 (F) The amount authorized to be appro-
4 priated in section 4401 for military personnel,
5 Air National Guard is hereby increased by
6 \$3,778,950.

7 (G) The amount authorized to be appro-
8 priated in section 4301 for operation and main-
9 tenance, Air Force Reserve, is hereby increased
10 by \$4,138,850.

11 (H) The amount authorized to be appro-
12 priated in section 4401 for military personnel,
13 Air Force Reserve, is hereby increased by
14 \$5398,499.

15 (I) The amount authorized to be appro-
16 priated in section 4301 for operation and main-
17 tenance, Navy Reserve, is hereby increased by
18 \$971,730.

19 (J) The amount authorized to be appro-
20 priated in section 4401 for military personnel,
21 Navy Reserve, is hereby increased by \$575,841.

22 (K) The amount authorized to be appro-
23 priated in section 4301 for operation and main-
24 tenance, Marine Corps Reserve, is hereby in-
25 creased by \$1,007,720.

1 (L) The amount authorized to be appro-
2 priated in section 4401 for military personnel,
3 Marine Corps Reserve, is hereby increased by
4 \$827,770.

5 (2) REDUCTIONS.—Notwithstanding the
6 amounts set forth in the funding tables in division
7 D, the following reductions are made:

8 (A) The amount authorized to be appro-
9 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
10 as specified in the corresponding funding table
11 in division D, is hereby reduced by \$5,000,000,
12 with the amount of the reduction to be derived
13 from Production Support.

14 (B) The amount authorized to be appro-
15 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
16 as specified in the corresponding funding table
17 in division D, is hereby reduced by \$5,000,000,
18 with the amount of the reduction to be derived
19 from research and development support.

20 (C) The amount authorized to be appro-
21 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
22 as specified in the corresponding funding table
23 in division D, is hereby reduced by \$9,000,000,
24 with the amount of the reduction to be derived
25 from management, technology, and production.

1 (D) The amount authorized to be appro-
2 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
3 as specified in the corresponding funding table
4 in division D, is hereby reduced by \$9,000,000,
5 with the amount of the reduction to be derived
6 from plutonium sustainment.

7 (E) The amount authorized to be appro-
8 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
9 as specified in the corresponding funding table
10 in division D, is hereby reduced by
11 \$29,400,000, with the amount of the reduction
12 to be derived from advanced certification.

13 (F) The amount authorized to be appro-
14 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
15 as specified in the corresponding funding table
16 in division D, is hereby reduced by \$7,000,000,
17 with the amount of the reduction to be derived
18 from primary assessment technologies.

19 (G) The amount authorized to be appro-
20 priated in section 4701 for Weapons Activities,
21 as specified in the corresponding funding table
22 in division D, is hereby reduced by \$8,000,000,
23 with the amount of the reduction to be derived
24 from dynamic materials properties.
