

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4970, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. SCOTT OF VIRGINIA

Page 176, strike lines 5 through 12 and insert the following:

1 “(B) if, in the course of committing the
2 violation of paragraph (1), the person engages
3 in conduct that would constitute an offense
4 under section 2241 or 2242 if committed in the
5 special maritime and territorial jurisdiction of
6 the United States, be subject to the penalties
7 provided for under section 2241 or 2242, re-
8 spectively, except that no mandatory minimum
9 provision shall apply.”.

Page 176, strike line 24 and all that follows through page 177, line 4 and insert the following:

10 “(b) PENALTIES.—A person who violates subsection
11 (a) shall be subject to the penalties under the provision
12 of chapter 109A that would have been violated if the con-
13 duct was committed in the special maritime and territorial
14 jurisdiction of the United States, unless a greater penalty
15 is otherwise authorized by law, except that any provision

1 for a mandatory minimum under chapter 109A shall not
2 apply.”.

Page 184, strike line 22 and all that follows through
page 185, line 8.
