15	(2) An analysis of Iran's labeling practices of

(e) Form.—
(1) In general.—The report required by para-
graph (1) shall be submitted in unclassified form,
but may contain a classified annex if necessary.
(2) Public availability of information.—
The unclassified portion of such report shall be
made available on a publicly available internet
website of the Federal Government.
(d) TERMINATION.—The requirement to submit the
report required by paragraph (1) shall cease upon the sub-
mission to Congress of the certification required by section
8 of the Iran Sanctions Act of 1996 (50 U.S.C. 1701
note).
(e) Petroleum Products.—In this section, the
term "petroleum products" includes crude oil, lease con-
densates, plant condensates, fuel oils, other unfinished
oils, liquefied petroleum gases, and other petroleum prod-
