

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-54
OFFERED BY MR. MALINOWSKI OF NEW JERSEY

At the of title LVIII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 58__ . TRANSPARENCY AND ACCOUNTABILITY OF INDI-**
2 **VIDUALS SANCTIONED FOR INVOLVEMENT IN**
3 **THE MURDER OF WASHINGTON POST JOUR-**
4 **NALIST JAMAL KHASHOGGI.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
6 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State
7 shall use the authorities established under section 7031(c)
8 of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2022 (Public Law
9 117-103) to disclose publicly the names of the individuals
10 described in subsection (b).

11 (b) INDIVIDUALS DESCRIBED.—The individuals de-
12 scribed in this subsection are the 76 individuals denied
13 entry to the United States as announced by the Secretary
14 of State on February 27, 2021, in the press statement
15 entitled “Accountability for the Murder of Jamal
16 Khashoggi” for involvement in the murder of Washington
17 Post journalist Jamal Khashoggi.

18 (c) EXCEPTIONS FOR NON-APPLICABILITY OF SEC-
19 TION 7031(C) AUTHORITIES.—If any of the individuals
20 described in subsection (b) do not meet the criteria under

1 section 7031(e) of the Consolidated Appropriations Act,
2 2022 for “direct or indirect involvement in a gross viola-
3 tion of human rights”, then the Secretary shall provide
4 to Congress a written notice thereof.

5 (d) WAIVER.—The Secretary of State may waive the
6 requirement under subsection (a) with respect to an indi-
7 vidual described in subsection (b) if the Secretary submits
8 to Congress a written notice a description of the damage
9 to United States national security that would result from
10 the public disclosure of the name of the individual

11 (e) NOTICE CONTENTS.—The notice required by sub-
12 sections (c) and (d) shall be provided in unclassified form
13 and shall include, with respect to an individual described
14 in subsection (b)—

15 (1) the actions or abuses that led to the individ-
16 ual’s inclusion in the announcement and press state-
17 ment described in subsection (b);

18 (2) the citizenship of the individual;

19 (3) if applicable, the government on behalf of
20 whom the individual was acting; and

21 (4) the country or countries in which the indi-
22 vidual’s actions or abuses took place.
