At the end of title LVIII, add the following:

1	SEC. 58 REPORT ON POLITICAL PRISONERS IN EGYPT.
2	(a) In General.—Not later than 180 days after the
3	date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,
4	in consultation with the Director of National Intelligence,
5	shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees
6	a report on the status of political prisoners in Egypt.
7	(b) Matters to Be Included.—The report re-
8	quired by subsection (a) shall include a detailed assess-
9	ment of how many individuals are detained, imprisoned,
10	or the victim of an enforced disappearance in Egypt, in-
11	cluding individuals who—
12	(1) are human rights defenders;
13	(2) are detained, imprisoned, or otherwise phys-
14	ically restricted because of their political, religious,
15	other conscientiously-held beliefs, or their identity;
16	(3) are prisoners who are arbitrarily detained;
17	(4) are victims of enforced disappearance or are
18	reasonably suspected of being detained or impris-
19	oned in a secret location; or

1	(5) have been subject to torture or other gross
2	violations of human rights while detained or impris-
3	oned.
1	(c) FORM.—The report required by subsection (a)
5	shall be submitted in unclassified form, but portions of
6	the report described in subsection (b) may contain a classi-
7	fied annex, so long as such annex is provided separately
3	from the unclassified report.
