

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13**  
**OFFERED BY MS. JACKSON LEE OF TEXAS**

Add at the end of subtitle D of title XV of division  
A the following:

1 **SEC. 15 \_\_ . STRATEGY TO SECURE EMAIL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than December 31,  
3 2022, the Secretary of Homeland Security shall develop  
4 and submit to Congress a strategy, including rec-  
5 ommendations, to implement across all United States-  
6 based email providers Domain-based Message Authentica-  
7 tion, Reporting, and Conformance standard at scale.

8 (b) ELEMENTS.—The strategy required under sub-  
9 section (a) shall include the following:

10 (1) A recommendation for the minimum size  
11 threshold for United States-based email providers  
12 for applicability of Domain-based Message Authen-  
13 tication, Reporting, and Conformance.

14 (2) A description of the security and privacy  
15 benefits of implementing the Domain-based Message  
16 Authentication, Reporting, and Conformance stand-  
17 ard at scale, including recommendations for national  
18 security exemptions, as appropriate, as well as the  
19 burdens of such implementation and an identifica-

1       tion of the entities on which such burdens would  
2       most likely fall.

3           (3) An identification of key United States and  
4       international stakeholders associated with such im-  
5       plementation.

6           (4) An identification of any barriers to such im-  
7       plementing, including a cost-benefit analysis where  
8       feasible.

9           (5) An initial estimate of the total cost to the  
10      Federal Government and implementing entities in  
11      the private sector of such implementing, including  
12      recommendations for defraying such costs, if appli-  
13      cable.

14      (c) CONSULTATION.—In developing the strategies  
15      and recommendations under subsection (a), the Secretary  
16      of Homeland Security may, as appropriate, consult with  
17      representatives from the information technology sector.

18      (d) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “Domain-  
19      based Message Authentication, Reporting, and Conform-  
20      ance” means an email authentication, policy, and report-  
21      ing protocol that verifies the authenticity of the sender of  
22      an email and blocks and reports to the sender fraudulent  
23      accounts.
