13	300u-11), would have on reducing the effects of obe-

15	such funding were not repealed and rescinded under

17	(2) the extent to which the repeal of the Pre-
18	vention and Public Health Fund and the rescission
19	of funds by section 1 will exacerbate such effects.

- 1 (b) Report.—Not later than 1 year after the date
- 2 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
- 3 Human Services shall submit a report to the Congress on
- 4 the results of the study under subsection (a).
