At the end of title I, add the following:

1 SEC. _____. STUDY OF NATIONAL MALL UNDERGROUND FA 2 CILITY.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall establish a 4 Commission (in this section referred to as the "Commis-5 sion") to carry out a study of the feasibility of creating 6 a facility underneath the National Mall providing water 7 management and flood control, together with parking and 8 visitor amenities (in this section referred to as the "Na-9 tional Mall Underground").

- 10 (b) Report.—
- (1) IN GENERAL.—The Commission shall provide a report to the Secretary concerning the feasibility of a National Mall Underground facility.

14 (2) MATTERS TO BE ADDRESSED.—The report
15 shall evaluate and make recommendations con16 cerning the suitability of the National Mall for a fa17 cility providing water management and flood protec-

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tion, and parking and visitor amenities, addressing
 the following:

3 (A) A water detention facility to receive
4 flood waters, and cisterns to collect ground5 water and rain water for National Mall irriga6 tion.

7 (B) Parking for tour buses and tourist
8 automobiles; a visitor center, restrooms, and
9 food service; security features; rest and service
10 areas for bus drivers; water management edu11 cation demonstration areas; pedestrian access to
12 Smithsonian museums; and access to Metro.

13 (C) Estimates of the facility's impacts on
14 area flood risks; stormwater, groundwater and
15 rainwater management; National Mall irrigation
16 requirements; costs for water and sewer service
17 and flood insurance; traffic circulation and air
18 quality; and tourism-related economy.

19 (D) Costs to construct and operate the Na-20 tional Mall Underground facility.

(3) USE OF EXISTING MATERIALS.—In preparing the report, the Commission shall review prior
studies and reports by Federal and District of Columbia agencies and nongovernmental organizations
addressing National Mall area flood and stormwater

risks, tourism and economic development, tourist
 parking needs, and traffic circulation patterns.

3 (c) DEADLINES.—The Commission shall submit final
4 reports required under subsection (b) not later than 12
5 months after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
