

AMENDMENT TO THE RULES COMMITTEE PRINT

OFFERED BY MS. LEE OF NEVADA

At the end of subtitle D of title X, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 10__.** **PROCESS TO FURNISH CERTAIN DEMO-**
2 **GRAPHIC DATA REGARDING MEMBERS OF**
3 **THE ARMED FORCES TO STATE EDU-**
4 **CATIONAL AGENCIES.**

5 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretaries concerned, in
6 consultation with the Secretary of Education, State edu-
7 cational agencies, local educational agencies, and experts
8 in student data and privacy, shall, not later than 18
9 months after the date of enactment of this Act, establish
10 a data sharing process that enables a State educational
11 agency to—

12 (1) access data described in subsection (b) at-
13 tributable to individuals who graduated high school
14 in the State of such State educational agency; and

15 (2) integrate such data into—

16 (A) such State’s statewide longitudinal
17 data system; or

1 (B) an alternate data system operated by
2 such State.

3 (b) DATA DESCRIBED.—The data described in this
4 paragraph may include the following information:

5 (1) With respect to an individual who is a mem-
6 ber of an Armed Force who graduated from sec-
7 ondary school:

8 (A) The highest level of education at-
9 tained.

10 (B) The name and location of the edu-
11 cational institution where the member received
12 education described in subparagraph (A).

13 (C) The name and location of the sec-
14 ondary school from which the individual grad-
15 uated.

16 (D) Score on the Armed Forces Qualifica-
17 tion Test.

18 (E) The date the member joined an Armed
19 Force.

20 (F) The Armed Force of the member.

21 (G) Rank.

22 (H) The area of expertise or military occu-
23 pational specialty.

24 (I) The date of separation, if applicable.

1 (J) Any other information determined ap-
2 propriate by the Secretary concerned.

3 (2) With respect to an individual who grad-
4 uated from secondary school and whose application
5 to join an Armed Force was denied:

6 (A) The highest level of education at-
7 tained.

8 (B) The name and location of the school
9 where the individual received education de-
10 scribed in subparagraph (A).

11 (C) The name and location of the sec-
12 ondary school from which the individual grad-
13 uated.

14 (D) Score on the Armed Forces Qualifica-
15 tion Test.

16 (c) PRIVACY.—

17 (1) CONFIDENTIALITY.—Data transmitted
18 through the data sharing process under subsection
19 (a) shall be transmitted confidentially and using the
20 most current standards for data security at the time
21 of transmission.

22 (2) PROTECTION OF INDIVIDUAL PRIVACY AND
23 DATA SECURITY.—The Secretaries concerned shall
24 carry out subsection (a) in a manner that protects
25 individual privacy and data security, in accordance

1 with applicable Federal, State, and local privacy
2 laws.

3 (3) DATA SECURITY PRACTICES.—Each Sec-
4 retary concerned and each State educational agency
5 that accesses data under subsection (a) shall estab-
6 lish, implement, and maintain reasonable data secu-
7 rity practices to protect—

8 (A) the confidentiality, integrity, and avail-
9 ability of data; and

10 (B) data against unauthorized access.

11 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

12 (1) The term “Secretary concerned” means—

13 (A) the Secretary of Defense; or

14 (B) the Secretary of Homeland Security.

15 (2) The terms “local educational agency”, “sec-
16 ondary school”, and “State educational agency”
17 have the meanings given such terms in section 8101
18 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of
19 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7801).
