

AMENDMENT TO SENATE AMENDMENTS TO H.R. 7148 – CONSOLIDATED
APPROPRIATIONS ACT, 2026
OFFERED BY MS. ANSARI OF ARIZONA

Add at the end the following:

**SEC. _____. PROHIBITION ON FUNDING FOR IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS
ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL.**

(a) Funding Prohibition.—

None of the funds made available by this Act, or any other Act making appropriations for the Department of Homeland Security, may be used to pay the salaries, wages, benefits, bonuses, overtime, travel, training, or operational expenses of any officer, agent, employee, detailee, or contractor of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

(b) Restriction on Hiring and Retention.—

No funds made available by this Act may be used by U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement to hire, retain, reassign, or detail any personnel.

(c) Transfer or Reprogramming Prohibited.—

Funds appropriated or otherwise made available to the Department of Homeland Security may not be transferred, reprogrammed, or otherwise made available for purposes prohibited under this section.

(d) Rule of Construction.—

Nothing in this section shall be construed to affect the authority of other components of the Department of Homeland Security, except that no such authority may be exercised in a manner that circumvents the funding prohibitions set forth in this section.

(e) Effective Date.—

This section shall take effect immediately upon enactment of this Act.
