

AMENDMENT

OFFERED BY MS. ANSARI OF ARIZONA

Insert at the appropriate place in the bill the following:

1 SEC. _____. (a) None of the funds made available by
2 this Act, or any other Act making appropriations for the
3 Department of Homeland Security, may be used by U.S.
4 Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) to carry
5 out enforcement, arrest, detention, transport, or removal
6 operations in which any ICE officer, agent, or contractor
7 wears a face mask, balaclava, or other face covering that
8 conceals the individual's identity.

9 (b) During any operation described in subsection (a),
10 ICE personnel shall—

11 (1) clearly display official identification, includ-
12 ing name or badge number; and

13 (2) verbally identify themselves as officers or
14 agents of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforce-
15 ment upon initial contact.

16 (c) The prohibition in subsection (a) shall not apply
17 if the face covering is—

18 (1) required for medical or public health rea-
19 sons;

1 (2) necessary for protection from environmental
2 hazards, including smoke, chemicals, or airborne de-
3 bris; or

4 (3) temporarily required as part of a specific,
5 documented undercover operation approved in writ-
6 ing by a supervisory official.

7 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to au-
8 thorize the use of force, reduce constitutional protections,
9 or limit the ability of individuals to identify, record, or
10 seek redress for the actions of ICE personnel.

11 (e) The Inspector General of the Department of
12 Homeland Security shall review compliance with this sec-
13 tion and submit a report to the Committees on Appropria-
14 tions of the House of Representatives and the Senate not
15 later than 30 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
