Add at the end the following:

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—This Act, including the amend-3 ments made by this Act, shall not take effect until the date on which the Administrator of the Environmental 4 5 Protection Agency issues a determination, made after con-6 sultation with the consortium described in subsection (b), 7 that the implementation of this Act, including the amendments made by this Act, will not increase pollution or dis-8 9 proportionately harm rural, Tribal, or underserved communities. 10

(b) CONSORTIUM.—The Administrator shall convene
a consortium of institutions of higher education (as defined in section 102 of the Higher Education Act of 1965
(20 U.S.C. 1002)) with relevant expertise in water quality,
environmental science, or public health, for purposes of
making a determination described in subsection (a). In
convening the consortium, the Administrator shall—
