Strike section 7111 and insert the following:

1 **SECTION 7111. ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS**

2 **FOR STUDENTS AT 1890 INSTITUTIONS.**

3 (a) **RENAMING PROGRAM.**—Section 1446 of the Na-  
4 tional Agricultural Research, Extension, and Teaching  
5 Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 3222a) is amended, in the  
6 section heading, by inserting “**(COMMONLY KNOWN AS**  
7 **THE DAVID A. SCOTT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR**  
8 **STUDENTS AT 1890 INSTITUTIONS)**” before the period  
9 at the end.

10 (b) **SCHOLARSHIPS FOR BACHELOR OR GRADUATE**  
11 **PROGRAMS.**—Section 1446(a)(1) of the National Agricul-  
12 tural Research, Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of  
13 1977 (7 U.S.C. 3222a(a)(1)) is amended by striking  
14 “scholarships to individuals” and inserting “scholarships  
15 (including for programs leading to a bachelor or graduate  
16 degree) to individuals”.

17 (c) **ANNUAL LIMITATION.**—Section 1446(a) of the  
18 National Agricultural Research, Extension, and Teaching

1 Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 3222a(a)) is amended by  
2 striking paragraph (3).

3 (d) MANDATORY FUNDING.—Section 1446(b)(1) of  
4 the National Agricultural Research, Extension, and  
5 Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 3222a(b)(1)) is  
6 amended by adding at the end the following:

7 “(D) FISCAL YEAR 2027 AND FISCAL  
8 YEARS THEREAFTER.—Of the funds of the  
9 Commodity Credit Corporation, the Secretary  
10 shall make available to carry out this section  
11 \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2027 and each fis-  
12 cal year thereafter, to remain available until ex-  
13 pended.”.

14 (e) DISCRETIONARY FUNDING.—Section 1446(b)(2)  
15 of the National Agricultural Research, Extension, and  
16 Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7 U.S.C. 3222a(b)(2)) is  
17 amended by striking “section \$10,000,000 for each of fis-  
18 cal years 2020 through 2023.” and inserting the following:

19 “section—

20 “(A) \$10,000,000 for each of fiscal years  
21 2020 through 2026; and

22 “(B) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2027 and  
23 each fiscal year thereafter.”.
