

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8146, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. ALLRED OF TEXAS**

Add at the end the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . STUDY ON ACCESSIBILITY OF MENTAL HEALTH**  
2 **PROVIDERS AND SERVICES FOR HOMELAND**  
3 **SECURITY PERSONNEL.**

4 (a) **STUDY.**—The Secretary of Homeland Security  
5 shall conduct a study on the accessibility of mental health  
6 care providers and services for personnel of the U.S. Cus-  
7 toms and Border Protection and U.S. Immigration and  
8 Customs Enforcement, including an assessment of—

9 (1) the accessibility of mental health care pro-  
10 viders;

11 (2) the accessibility of inpatient services for  
12 mental health care for such personnel; and

13 (3) any steps that may be taken to improve  
14 such accessibility.

15 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 180 days after the date  
16 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Homeland Secu-  
17 rity shall submit to the Committee on Homeland Security  
18 and Committee on Appropriations of the House of Rep-  
19 resentatives and the Committee on Homeland Security  
20 and Governmental Affairs and the Committee on Appro-

- 1 priations of the Senate a report containing the findings
- 2 of the study under subsection (a).
