

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119–8**  
**OFFERED BY MS. ANSARI OF ARIZONA**

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

**1 SEC. 17\_\_ . PERMANENT ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COORDI-**  
**2 NATOR ON GLOBAL ANTI-CORRUPTION.**

**3 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.**—There is permanently estab-  
**4 lished** within the Department of State the position of Co-  
**5 ordinator** on Global Anti-Corruption (in this section re-  
**6 ferred** to as the “Coordinator”).

**7 (b) APPOINTMENT.**—The Coordinator shall be ap-  
**8 pointed** by the President, by and with the advice and con-  
**9 sent** of the Senate, and shall report directly to the Sec-  
**10 retary** of State.

**11 (c) RANK AND STATUS.**—The Coordinator shall have  
**12 the** rank and status of Ambassador-at-Large.

**13 (d) RESPONSIBILITIES.**—The Coordinator shall—

**14 (1)** develop and oversee the implementation of  
**15 a** comprehensive U.S. strategy to combat global cor-  
**16 ruption**;

**17 (2)** coordinate anti-corruption efforts across  
**18 U.S.** departments and agencies, including the De-

1       partment of State, Department of Justice, Depart-  
2       ment of the Treasury, and other relevant entities;

3           (3) represent the United States in international  
4       forums and bilateral engagements related to anti-  
5       corruption initiatives;

6           (4) provide guidance to U.S. embassies and  
7       missions on anti-corruption policies and programs;

8           (5) collaborate with international organizations,  
9       foreign governments, and civil society to advance  
10      global anti-corruption efforts; and

11          (6) submit an annual report to Congress on the  
12      activities, progress, and challenges of U.S. anti-cor-  
13      ruption initiatives, including recommendations for  
14      legislative or policy actions.

15      (e) FUNDING.—The Secretary of State shall ensure  
16      sufficient funding and resources are allocated to support  
17      the Office of the Coordinator, subject to the availability  
18      of appropriations.

19      (f) PERMANENCE.—The position of Coordinator on  
20      Global Anti-Corruption shall remain a permanent office  
21      within the Department of State and shall not be subject  
22      to termination or restructuring unless terminated or re-  
23      structured pursuant to an Act of Congress.
