

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MS. ANSARI OF ARIZONA

Add at the end of subtitle B of title XVII the following:

1 **SEC. 17____. PROHIBITION ON AI-BASED IMPERSONATION**
2 **OF FEDERAL OFFICIALS.**

3 Section 912 of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended—

5 (1) by striking “Whoever” and inserting the following:
6 lowing:

7 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Whoever”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

9 “(b) USE OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE.—

10 “(1) AI.—Whoever knowingly uses artificial intelligence to impersonate, falsely assume, or pretend
11 telligence to impersonate, falsely assume, or pretend
12 to be an officer or employee of the United States, including by mimicking the voice or likeness of a Federal
13 officer without an explicit disclaimer, and thereby produces materially false or misleading content
14 shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not
15 more than three years, or both.

17 “(2) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in
18 this subsection shall be construed to limit legitimate
19 this subsection shall be construed to limit legitimate

1 uses of artificial intelligence for the creation of con-
2 tent that is a satire, parody, or expressive conduct
3 protected under the First Amendment, if such con-
4 tent includes a clear disclosure that the content is
5 not authentic.

6 “(3) DEFINITION.—In this section—

7 “(A) the term ‘artificial intelligence’ means
8 any system or software that performs tasks
9 normally requiring human intelligence, includ-
10 ing generative models capable of producing
11 human-like audio, video, or text; and

12 “(B) the term ‘impersonates’ means to
13 falsely represent oneself as another identifiable
14 individual, whether real or fictitious, in a man-
15 ner reasonably likely to cause another person to
16 believe the content is authentic.”.
