

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8595, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MS. ANSARI OF ARIZONA**

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1       SEC. \_\_. Of the amounts made available in this Act  
2 to the Department of State for anti-corruption activities,  
3 \$5,000,000 shall be made available to—

4           (1) develop and oversee the implementation of  
5 a comprehensive U.S. strategy to combat global cor-  
6 ruption;

7           (2) coordinate anti-corruption efforts across  
8 U.S. departments and agencies, including the De-  
9 partment of State, Department of Justice, Depart-  
10 ment of the Treasury, and other relevant entities;

11          (3) represent the United States in international  
12 forums and bilateral engagements related to anti-  
13 corruption initiatives;

14          (4) provide guidance to U.S. embassies and  
15 missions on anti-corruption policies and programs;

16          (5) collaborate with international organizations,  
17 foreign governments, and civil society to advance  
18 global anti-corruption efforts; and

1           (6) submit an annual report to Congress on the  
2           activities, progress, and challenges of U.S. anti-cor-  
3           ruption initiatives, including recommendations for  
4           legislative or policy actions.
