Strike the text of the Rules Committee Print and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Restaurant Revitaliza-
3 tion Fund Fairness Act”.

4 SEC. 2. RESTAURANT REVITALIZATION GRANTS FOR CER-
5 TAIN ELIGIBLE APPLICANT.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Small
7 Business Administration shall, in accordance with section
8 5003(c) of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (15
9 U.S.C. 9009c(c)), award grants to eligible applicants.

10 (b) REVIEW.—The Administrator shall review and
11 process applications from eligible applicants in the order
12 in which they were originally received.

13 (c) REPEAL.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—Paragraph (3) of section
15 5003(c) of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021
16 (15 U.S.C. 9009c(c)(3)) is repealed.

17 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
18 5003(c)(1) of the American Rescue Plan Act of

1 2021 (15 U.S.C. 9009c(c)(1)) is amended by strik-
2 ing “and paragraph (3)”.

3 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

4 (1) ADMINISTRATOR.—The term “Adminis-
5 trator” means the Administrator of the Small Busi-
6 ness Administration.

7 (2) COVERED PERIOD; ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—The
8 terms “covered period” and “eligible entity” have
9 the meanings given, respectively, in section 5003(a)
10 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (15
11 U.S.C. 9009c(a)).

12 (3) ELIGIBLE APPLICANT.—The term “eligible
13 applicant” means one of the 177,300 eligible entities
14 identified by the Administrator that applied during
15 the covered period for a grant under section 5003(c)
16 of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (15
17 U.S.C. 9009c(e)) and was not awarded such a grant.

18 (e) APPROPRIATION; OFFSET.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—There is appropriated, out
20 of amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appro-
21 priated, for the fiscal year ending September 30,
22 2022, \$43,658,300,559, to remain available until ex-
23 pended, for the Administrator to carry out this sec-
24 tion.

1 (2) OFFSET.—Not later than 30 days after the
2 date of the enactment of this Act, there are hereby
3 rescinded \$43,658,300,559, to be derived, as deter-
4 mined by the Secretary of the Treasury, from the
5 unobligated amounts available under the following:

6 (A) The Coronavirus Preparedness and
7 Response Supplemental Appropriations Act,
8 2020 (Public Law 116–123).

9 (B) The Families First Coronavirus Re-
10 sponse Act (Public Law 116–127).

11 (C) The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Eco-
12 nomic Security Act (Public Law 116–136).

13 (D) The Paycheck Protection Program and
14 Health Care Enhancement Act (Public Law
15 116–139).

16 (E) Divisions M and N of the Consolidated
17 Appropriations Act, 2021 (Public Law 116–
18 260).

19 (F) The American Rescue Plan Act of
20 2021 (Public Law 117–2).
