1SECTION 875. DOD PROCUREMENT RESTRICTIONS ON2ADULTERATED OR MISLABELED HONEY CON-3DIMENTS.

4 (a) LIMITATION PROCUREMENT ON THE OF HONEY.—Beginning on the date on which the standard 5 of identity for honey required under subsection (b)(1) is 6 established, the Secretary of Defense may procure con-7 8 diment honey only if such condiment honey meets the re-9 quirements of such standard.

10 (b) Standard of Identity for Honey.—

(1) STANDARD.—Not later than 1 year after
the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
of Health and Human Services, acting through the
Commissioner of Food and Drugs, shall establish a
standard of identity for honey in accordance with
applicable United States Pharmacopeia standards

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under section 401 of the Federal Food, Drug, and
 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 341).

3 (2) Report to congress on enforcement 4 ACTIONS WITH RESPECT TO MISBRANDED HONEY.-Not later than 2 years after the date of the enact-5 6 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and 7 Human Services, acting through the Commissioner 8 of Food and Drugs, shall submit a report to the 9 Congress on enforcement actions taken under the 10 Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 11 301 et seq.) with respect to honey that is adulter-12 ated under section 402 of such Act (21 U.S.C. 342) 13 and honey that is misbranded under section 403 of 14 such Act (21 U.S.C. 343). Such report shall be 15 made in consultation with the Secretary of Defense 16 and shall make specific reference to enforcement ac-17 tions taken involving Department of Defense pro-18 curements.
