1 any officer or employee of the United States or of any 2 agency in any branch of the United States Government (including any member of the uniformed services) while 3 4 engaged in or on account of the performance of official 5 duties, or any person who formerly served as a person de-6 fined above on account of the performance of official du-7 ties during such person's term of service shall be punished 8 as provided in subsection (b).

9 "(b) PUNISHMENT.—A violation of subsection (a)10 shall be punished as follows:

"(1) For a violation of paragraph (1) of such
subsection, by a fine under this title of not less than
\$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 1
year, or both.

"(2) For a violation of paragraph (2) of such
subsection, by a fine under this title of not less than
\$2,500 or by imprisonment for not more than 10
years, or both.

"(3) For a violation of paragraph (3) of such
subsection, by a fine under this title of not less than
\$10,000 or by mandatory imprisonment, or both.".
