OFFERED BY MR. ARRINGTON OF TEXAS

Page 2, after line 24, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 3. ASSAULTING, RESISTING, OR IMPEDING CERTAIN**
2 **OFFICERS OR EMPLOYEES.**

3 Section 111 of title 18, United States Code, is
4 amended to read as follows:

5 **“§ 111. Assaulting, resisting, or impeding certain offi-**
6 **cers or employees**

7 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Whoever knowingly—

8 “(1) forcibly assaults, resists, opposes, impedes,
9 intimidates, or interferes while performing official
10 duties,

11 “(2) makes physical contact with or has the in-
12 tent to commit another felony while acting under
13 paragraph (1), or

14 “(3) uses a deadly or dangerous weapon against
15 (including a weapon intended to cause death or dan-
16 ger but that fails to do so by reason of a defective
17 component) or inflicts bodily injury while acting
18 under paragraph (1),

1 any officer or employee of the United States or of any
2 agency in any branch of the United States Government
3 (including any member of the uniformed services) while
4 engaged in or on account of the performance of official
5 duties, or any person who formerly served as a person de-
6 fined above on account of the performance of official du-
7 ties during such person's term of service shall be punished
8 as provided in subsection (b).

9 “(b) PUNISHMENT.—A violation of subsection (a)
10 shall be punished as follows:

11 “(1) For a violation of paragraph (1) of such
12 subsection, by a fine under this title of not less than
13 \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 1
14 year, or both.

15 “(2) For a violation of paragraph (2) of such
16 subsection, by a fine under this title of not less than
17 \$2,500 or by imprisonment for not more than 10
18 years, or both.

19 “(3) For a violation of paragraph (3) of such
20 subsection, by a fine under this title of not less than
21 \$10,000 or by mandatory imprisonment, or both.”.
