Add at the end of title XVIII the following:

## 1 SEC. 18\_\_\_\_\_. SENSE OF CONGRESS AND DECLARATION RE 2 GARDING INVASION OF UNITED STATES BY 3 FOREIGN ADVERSARY.

4 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-5 gress that United States is being invaded and is in immi-6 nent danger from a foreign adversary, a paramilitary 7 narco-terrorist cartel army supported by the Peoples Republic of China, and other countries harboring and sup-8 9 porting known terrorists, and this invasion and imminent danger is a threat to our national security and pursuant 10 11 to Article IV, Section 4 of the United States Constitution, 12 "The United States shall guarantee to every State in this 13 Union a Republican Form of Government, and shall protect each of them against Invasion.". 14

(b) DECLARATION.—Congress declares and finds as
a matter of fact the United States is being invaded by
a foreign adversary and such invasion shall be repelled
pursuant to Article IV, Section 4 of the United States

- 1 Constitution, in accordance with the Federal Govern-
- 2 ment's duty to protect every State against an invasion.
