2 Congress finds as follows:

(1) Any State within the United States has the sovereign right to exclude from the sovereign's territory any person who does not have the right to be there.

(2) The States at our southern border, including Texas, New Mexico, Arizona, and California, are being invaded or are in such imminent danger from paramilitary, narco-terrorist cartels, terrorists and criminal actors as will not admit delay as stated in article I, section 10 of the United States Constitution and those States have the sovereign and unilateral authority pursuant to article I, section 10 of the United States Constitution to defend themselves against the invasion or imminent danger by paramilitary, narco-terrorist cartels, terrorists and criminal actors.

1	(3) The United States has failed to protect the
2	aforementioned States at our southern border
3	against invasion pursuant to article IV, section 4 of
4	the United States Constitution or to "ensure domes-
5	tic tranquility", "provide for the common defense",
6	and "execute the laws" of the United States.
7	(4) The Biden administration has failed to
8	faithfully execute the laws of the United States and
9	to defend and protect the aforementioned States on
10	the southern border against invasion or imminent
11	danger.
