

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-**

**OFFERED BY MR. AUCHINCLOSS OF  
MASSACHUSETTS**

At the end of subtitle E of title V, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 5\_\_\_ . INSPECTOR GENERAL REPORT ON COMPLIANCE**  
2 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE WITH RE-**  
3 **QUIREMENTS TO SUBMIT INFORMATION TO**  
4 **THE NATIONAL INSTANT CRIMINAL BACK-**  
5 **GROUND CHECK SYSTEM.**

6 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days  
7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Inspector  
8 General of the Department of Defense shall submit to  
9 Congress, the Department of Justice, and the Department  
10 of Defense a report that evaluates the compliance of the  
11 Department of Defense with requirements relating to the  
12 submission of information to the Federal Bureau of Inves-  
13 tigation for inclusion in the national instant criminal back-  
14 ground check system.

15 (b) ELEMENTS.—The report under subsection (a)  
16 shall address the following:

1           (1) The status of the compliance of military  
2 criminal investigative organizations with Department  
3 of Defense policies and Federal laws requiring the  
4 submission of information to the national instant  
5 criminal background check system.

6           (2) Whether and to what extent the information  
7 submitted to the national instant criminal back-  
8 ground check system by military criminal investiga-  
9 tive organizations includes—

10                   (A) fingerprints;

11                   (B) final disposition reports for offenses  
12 committed under chapter 47 of title 10, United  
13 States Code (the Uniform Code of Military Jus-  
14 tice);

15                   (C) DNA information;

16                   (D) Sex Offender Registration and Notifi-  
17 cation Act information; and

18                   (E) information relevant to whether an in-  
19 dividual is prohibited from receipt of a firearm  
20 pursuant to subsection (g) or (n) of section 922  
21 of title 18, United States Code.

22           (3) Whether and to what extent the Depart-  
23 ment of Defense has implemented policies, processes,  
24 training, and management oversight procedures to  
25 enhance the collection and submission of criminal

- 2 background check system.
