

AMENDMENT TO
RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-40
OFFERED BY MR. MOYLAN OF GUAM

At the end of the bill (before the short title), insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . AUTHORITY FOR INDO-PACIFIC POSTURE UN-**
2 **SPECIFIED MILITARY CONSTRUCTION**
3 **PROJECTS.**

4 Section 2810 of the National Defense Authorization
5 Act For Fiscal Year 2024, titled “Authority for Indo-Pa-
6 cific Posture Unspecified Minor Military Construction
7 Projects” enacted December 22, 2023 (Public Law 118-
8 31, 137 Stat 136) is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (b), by striking all text in sub-
10 paragraph (2) following “to the extent necessary”
11 and inserting replacement text: “as either a stand-
12 alone transaction or as part of a minor military con-
13 struction project, any acquisition of interests in
14 land, or support or reimbursement for acquisition of
15 interests in land for establishment of a defense site
16 or other area over which the Secretary of a military
17 department or the Secretary of Defense will exercise

1 operational control, without regard to the duration
2 of the operational control”;

3 (2) in subsection (c), by striking the “or” fol-
4 lowing subparagraph (2) and inserting “; or” after
5 subparagraph (3) and by inserting at the end the
6 following new subparagraph:

7 “(4) acquiring interests in land, defense sites,
8 or operational control over areas needed to support
9 another project or projects under this section or to
10 support a future military construction project.”;

11 (3) in subsection (d) following “military instal-
12 lation” insert “or planned military installation”; and

13 (4) in subsection (e) at the end of subpara-
14 graph (2) following “Code” insert “; provided how-
15 ever that this amount shall be adjusted upward to
16 reflect a construction cost index published pursuant
17 to section 2805(f) of title 10, United States Code
18 when such an index applies to the location of the
19 project; except that the adjusted amount may not
20 exceed the limit established in subsection (a) of this
21 section”.
