**OFFERED BY MR. WILSON OF SOUTH CAROLINA**

At the end of subtitle A of title XII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 12\_\_ . AUTHORIZATION OF ACTIVITIES TO COUNTER**  
2 **RUSSIA.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense, with  
4 the concurrence of the Secretary of State and the head  
5 of any other Federal department or agency the Secretary  
6 of Defense determines relevant, may provide training,  
7 equipment, and institutional support to the national secu-  
8 rity forces of partner countries and actors in the Balkans  
9 and the Middle East to build capacity to counter malign  
10 influence by the Russian Federation and destabilizing ac-  
11 tivities.

12 (b) TRAINING AGREEMENTS AUTHORIZATION.—Pur-  
13 suant to section 333 of title 10, United States Code, the  
14 Secretary of Defense is hereby authorized to enter into  
15 bilateral or multilateral training agreements to build ca-  
16 pacity in the following areas:

17 (1) Civil-military cooperation and regional co-  
18 ordination.

- 1           (2) Integrated air and missile defense.
- 2           (3) Interoperability with United States armed
- 3           forces and NATO partners.
- 4           (4) Joint exercises and military planning.
- 5           (5) Cyber defense and resilience infrastructure.
- 6           (6) Counter-disinformation and strategic com-
- 7           munications programs.
- 8           (7) Civil defense and rapid response capabili-
- 9           ties.
- 10          (c) SUNSET.—The authority provided under this sec-
- 11          tion shall expire on the date this is 3 years after the date
- 12          of enactment of this Act.
