Add at the end of subtitle B of title XII of division A the following:

1	SEC. 12 THREAT ASSESSMENT OF TERRORIST THREATS
2	POSED BY PRISONERS RELEASED BY
3	TALIBAN IN AFGHANISTAN.
4	(a) THREAT ASSESSMENT.—
5	(1) IN GENERAL.—The Director of National In-
6	telligence, in coordination with the Secretary of
7	Homeland Security, the Secretary of Defense and
8	the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation,
9	shall conduct a threat assessment of terrorist threats
10	to the United States posed by the prisoners released
11	by the Taliban from the Pul-e-Charkhi Prison and
12	Parwan Detention Facility in Afghanistan.
13	(2) ELEMENTS.—The assessment required
14	under paragraph (1) shall include the following:
15	(A) With respect to the prisoners released
16	by the Taliban from the Pul-e-Charkhi Prison
17	and Parwan Detention Facility in Afghanistan,
18	information relating to—

1	(i) the number of such prisoners who
2	were released;
3	(ii) the country of origin for each such
4	prisoner; and
5	(iii) any affiliation with a foreign ter-
6	rorist organization for each such prisoner.
7	(B) The capability of the Director of Na-
8	tional Intelligence to identify, track, and mon-
9	itor such prisoners and any associated chal-
10	lenges with such capability.
11	(C) Any action of the with respect to—
12	(i) mitigating the terrorist threats to
13	the United States posed by such prisoners;
14	and
15	(ii) preventing such prisoners from
16	entering the United States.
17	(b) CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION.—Not later than
18	60 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the
19	Secretary shall—
20	(1) submit to the appropriate congressional
21	committees the threat assessment required under
22	subsection (a); and
23	(2) provide a briefing to the appropriate con-
24	gressional committees on such assessment.
25	(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1	(1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
2	TEES.—The term "appropriate congressional com-
3	mittees" means the congressional defense commit-
4	tees and—
5	(A) the Committee on Homeland Security
6	and the Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
7	ligence of the House of Representatives; and
8	(B) the Committee on Homeland Security
9	and Governmental Affairs and the Select Com-
10	mittee on Intelligence of the Senate.
11	(2) Foreign terrorist organization.—The
12	term "foreign terrorist organization" means an or-
13	ganization designated as a foreign terrorist organiza-
14	tion under section 219 of the Immigration and Na-
15	tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189).
