## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118–11

## OFFERED BY MR. DONALDS OF FLORIDA

At the end of title VIII, add the following:

1	SEC EVALUATION OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLANS.
2	(a) IN GENERAL.—The Comptroller General of the
3	United States shall, in consultation with industry stake-
4	holders and the owners or operators of airports certified
5	by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administra-
6	tion, conduct an evaluation of a representative sample of
7	the emergency plans in place at such airports.
8	(b) Contents.—In conducting the evaluation under
9	subsection (a), the Comptroller General shall assess, with
10	respect to such airports, the following:
11	(1) Electricity supply on normal operating pro-
12	cedures.
13	(2) Resiliency plans for maintaining appropriate
14	electricity supply to continue airport operations in
15	the case a natural disaster disrupts the airport's pri-
16	mary power source.
17	(3) Backup electricity plans in the event a nat-
18	ural disaster disrupts, partially or completely, the
19	airport's primary power source.

1	(4) A comparison of previous versions of the
2	airport's emergency response plans and how current
3	and future airport emergency response plans may be
4	similar or different than the emergency response
5	plans of the past.
6	(5) The overall impact of an airport losing its
7	primary power source on communities surrounding
8	the airport and any public health and safety risks
9	that may result.
10	(c) Submission.—Not later than 1 year after the
11	date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
12	shall submit to the Committee on Transportation and In-
13	frastructure of the House of Representatives and the Com-
14	mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the
15	Senate a report containing the results of the evaluation
16	conducted under subsection (a).
