At the end of title VIII, add the following:

1 SEC. _____. REQUIREMENTS FOR COMMERCIAL AIR TOUR 2 FLIGHTS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi4 sion of law, a commercial air tour may not operate at an
5 altitude of less than 1,500 feet.

6 (b) EXCEPTIONS.—

7 (1) SAFE HARBOR.—An operator of a commer8 cial air tour may fly below the altitude described in
9 subsection (a) for reasons of safety if unpredictable
10 circumstances occur.

(2) FAA REQUIREMENTS.—The Administrator
may permit an operator of a commercial air tour to
operate below the altitude described in subsection

14 (a) for flight operations for takeoff and landing.

(c) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—If a reasonable individual would believe a commercial air tour could not safely
fly at a minimum altitude of 1,500 feet for the duration

- 1 of the flight given the conditions at takeoff, the safe har-
- 2 bor described in subsection (b)(1) shall not apply.
